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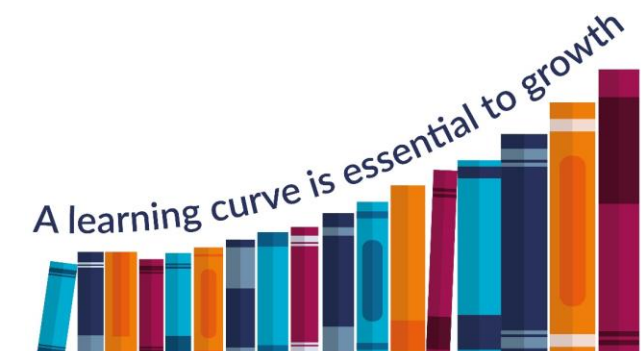

Early reading has been prioritised to ensure that pupils improve their accuracy and fluency in reading. Staff have received appropriate training to implement the school's phonics programme. Children in Reception, and particularly pupils in Year 1, are rapidly improving their achievement in reading. Pupils at an early stage of beginning to read are receiving the extra help they need. Furthermore, the school has invested in a broad range of new reading books that stimulate pupils' interests and that promote their understanding of life in modern Britain. Pupils enjoy story time and discussing their learning in these sessions.

The teaching of reading is a priority. Many children have speech and language difficulties when they start school. Children begin to learn to read as soon as they start at the school. They receive intensive support to catch up.
